Abstract Submission Guidelines

Deadline – Tuesday, July 31, 2018

The abstract should contain a summary of the essential scientific information (must be scientific in nature) and neither promotional nor commercial in tone. Specifically,

- The abstracts should be in English language only and in the Word format (no PDF).
 Abbreviations may be used in the body of an abstract. However, they should be defined at the first mention in the text.
- 2. Abstract must be typed in Calibri font, 12 pt with less than 300 words (i.e., The abstract body should not exceed 300 words, excluding title, author and institution list).
- 3. **Authors:** Include all the names and underline the presenting author. Number the corresponding institution in numbered superscript after their name (e.g. <u>Peter T. Smith</u>¹, Paul A. Jones²).
- 4. **Affiliation:** Include all the affiliations. The affiliation should include Department name, Institution name, City, State and Country.
- 5. Authors must accept sole responsibility for the statements and accuracy in the abstract.
- 6. Please email abstracts to Roben Brooks (rbrooks@aralliance.org) no later than July 31, 2018. Acceptance letter will be sent out to the presenting authors by Friday, August 17, 2018.
