The abstract should contain a summary of the essential scientific information (must be scientific in nature) and neither promotional nor commercial in tone.

- 1. Proof of conference registration must be provided at the time of abstract submission for an abstract to be considered.**
2. Abstracts must be in English only. Abbreviations may be used in the abstract body and must be defined at their first appearance.
3. The abstract body, excluding title, authors and affiliations, must **not exceed 300 words**.
4. Authors must accept sole responsibility for the statements and accuracy in the abstract.
